

CV Dorette Corbey

Dr Dorette Corbey was member of the European Parliament (EP) from 1999 until 2009 representing the Dutch Labour Party. As member of the EP environment committee and the EP industry committee, she focused on energy, research, innovation, climate change, health and fisheries. Dr Corbey was rapporteur for the fuel quality directive, renewable energy, packaging directive and air quality. She also was member of the China delegation.

Currently Dr Corbey is director of the Advisory Council for Science, Technology and Innovation. Dr Corbey holds a second position, i.e. chairperson of a committee on sustainable biomass. This committee consists of representatives of oil companies, food companies, electricity companies, scientist and NGO's. It produced so far 12 papers on sustainability issues, available on www.corbey.nl. Thirdly, Dr Corbey is appointed president of the Dutch Emissions Authority, the Authority that is responsible for supervision and control of the CO2 emissions under the Emission Trading System.

Dorette Corbey started her career as a nurse. She studied geography in the 1980s at the University of Amsterdam. She worked as a researcher for The Netherlands Institute for foreign relation "Clingendael". Her PhD was at Leiden University in 1993. She joined the trade union movement in order to work on European relations. Academic publications of Dorette Corbey can be found in International Organization, de Internationale Spectator and Socialisme & Democratie. Around 40 essays were published in various newspapers, magazines and books.

Dr Corbey was born in Eindhoven in 1957 and currently lives in Haarlem, the Netherlands.
